

*Now begins the intensive scrutiny or testing by the religious elite, as spoken in Exodus 12 the lamb was to be brought into the home for 5 days and scrutinized, inspected to see if it is worthy of sacrifice.*

Sermon # 638

Mt 22:1 ¶ And Jesus answered and **spoke to them** (*chief priests and Pharisees*) **again by parables** and said:

2 "The kingdom of heaven is like **a certain king who arranged a marriage for his son,**

- *Cross reference;* Ge 24 Abraham sending his servant to seek out a wife, Rebecca, for his son Isaac.

3 "and sent out his servants to call those who were invited to the wedding; and **they were not willing to come.**

4 "**Again, he sent out other servants,** saying, 'Tell those who are invited, "See, I have prepared my dinner; my oxen and fatted cattle are killed, and all things are ready. Come to the wedding.'"

5 "**But they made light of it and went their ways,** one to his own farm, another to his business.

6 "And **the rest seized his servants,** treated them spitefully, and killed them.

- **Lu 11:47** "Woe to you! For you build the tombs of the prophets, and your fathers killed them.

7 "But **when the king heard about it, he was furious.** And he sent out his armies, **destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city.**

- The fate of Jerusalem and all those who rejected the Lord's gracious invitation in 70 AD

8 "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding is ready, but **those who were invited were not worthy.**

9 'Therefore **go into the highways,** and as many as you find, invite to the wedding.'

10 "So those servants went out into the highways and gathered together all whom they found, **both bad and good.** And the wedding hall was filled with guests.

- **Mt 28:19** "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

11 "But when the king came in to see the guests, **he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment.**

12 "So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment?' And he was speechless.

- **Isa 61:10** ¶ I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, My soul shall be joyful in my God; For He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, As a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, And as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

13 "Then the king said to the servants, '**Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'**

- As the Tares among the wheat so there will be among us those un-prepared for the Kingdom again as the 10 virgins, the wise came prepared with oil and the foolish were not properly prepared.

14 "**For many are called, but few are chosen.**"

**15 ¶** Then **the Pharisees** went and plotted how they might entangle Him in His talk.

16 And they sent to Him **their disciples with the Herodians,** saying, "**Teacher, we know that You are true, and teach the way of God in truth; nor do You care about anyone, for You do not regard the person of men.**

17 "Tell us, therefore, what do You think? **Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?"**

18 But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, "**Why do you test Me, you hypocrites?**

19 "Show Me the tax money." So they brought Him a denarius.

20 And He said to them, "Whose image and inscription is this?"

21 They said to Him, "Caesar's." And **He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's."**

22 When they had heard these words, they marveled, and left Him and went their way.

**23 ¶** The same day **the Sadducees, who say there is no resurrection,** came to Him and asked Him,

24 saying: "Teacher, Moses said that if a man dies, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife and raise up offspring for his brother.

25 "Now there were with us seven brothers. The first died after he had married, and having no offspring, left his wife to his brother.

26 "Likewise the second also, and the third, even to the seventh.

27 "Last of all the woman died also.

28 **"Therefore, in the resurrection, whose wife of the seven will she be? For they all had her."**

29 Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God.

30 **"For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels of God in heaven.**

- **1Co 15:35-38** ¶ But someone will say, "How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?" 36 Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies. 37 And what you sow, you do not sow that body that shall be, but mere grain--perhaps wheat or some other grain. 38 But **God gives it a body as He pleases**, and to each seed its own body.

31 "But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying,

32 **'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.'** (*Ex 3:6*)

- **I am** (*present tense*) the God, not **I was** (*past tense*) the God

33 And when the multitudes heard this, they were astonished at His teaching.

**34** ¶ But when the Pharisees heard that He had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together.

35 Then one of them, **a lawyer**, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying,

36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"

37 Jesus said to him, "**You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.'**

**38 "This is the first and great commandment.**

**39 "And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'**

**40 "On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."**

- **1Jo 4:19-21** We love Him because He first loved us. 20 If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen? 21 And this commandment we have from Him: that he who loves God must love his brother also.

**41** ¶ While the Pharisees were gathered together, **Jesus asked them,**

42 saying, "**What do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?**" They said to Him, "**The Son of David.**"

43 He said to them, "**How then does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying:**

**44 'The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"'**? (*Ps 110*)

**45 "If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his Son?"**

- You see Jesus is both Lord and Son He is both Divine and human.

46 And no one was able to answer Him a word, nor **from that day on did anyone dare question Him anymore.**

- It took a unsaved gentile to declare Him!
- **Lu 23:4** So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, "**I find no fault in this Man.**"
